Stakeholder engagement has taken place through existing stakeholder steering groups like the Inshore Fisheries Partnership, MarPAMM MPA management plan steering groups and the Strangford Lough and Lecale Partnership (SLLP). More focussed engagement with interest groups, NGOs, fish processors has also taken place. This engagement has listened to the needs of individuals and groups and taken their concerns into account when formulating the potential management measures. The purpose of the call for evidence document is to obtain more information to better quantify the intertidal shellfish gathering fishery and the impact that could occur as a result of changes in the management of current fishing practices. Specific questions have been included in the consultation document questionnaire to address the lack of information the Department currently holds and allow more accurate assessment of the impacts to rural communities.
