## **TRACES Classic INTRA Certification Update**

### Model ITAHC 91/68 (2020/772) Ell Ovine/Caprine for Fattening

ITAHC 91/68 EII (2020/772) previously used for certification of fattening sheep has been withdrawn from TRACES Classic in advance of further changes to be introduced later in the year relating to the introduction of the new Animal Health Law certificates.

We have been advised by the TRACES Helpdesk that the breeding ITAHC 91/68 EIII (2020/772) is to be used for both breeding and fattening of sheep.
