Subject: Changes to official certification and associated SHA guidance

Scope

The purpose of this bulletin is to make authorised Private Veterinary Practitioners in Northern Ireland aware of:

- the changes to official certification of products of animal origin (POAO) from Great Britain (GB) to EU and Northern Ireland (NI)
- DAERA guidance on the requirement for support health attestations (SHAs) to accompany product moving from NI to GB
- DAERA guidance on the movement of poultry POAO from AI restricted zones in NI to GB and EU
