

## <u>DAERA Stakeholder/Industry – TRACES NT DOCOMS</u> <u>Update</u>

Subject: TRACES NT - New arrangements to notify Member States of exports of the above products

## TRACES NT – NOTIFICATION OF MOVEMENTS OF CERTAIN ANIMAL BY-PRODUCTS AND DERIVED PRODUCTS NOT INTENDED FOR HUMAN CONSUMPTION (DOCOMs).

The EU is currently moving all intra-EU trade export applications from TRACES Classic to TRACES NT (TNT). Export health certificates for live animals and germplasm and journey log modules are already in place and being used.

The latest module, introduced on 6 December 2021, is for the purpose of notifying Member States of the movement of certain **animal by-products/ derived products not intended for human consumption (DOCOMs)**.

It is now the responsibility of the exporter (referred to as an Economic Operator on TNT) to complete these on TNT.

In order to be able to do this and then complete the DOCOM you will initially need to create an EU Login account and register on TNT. Once you have successfully created your account and have access to TNT, you will have the necessary access to the DOCOM module of TNT. Please note that the ability to create a DOCOM on TNT will not be available to DAERA staff.

Further guidance on the completion of DOCOMs on TNT will be circulated when made available by the EU Commission. We advise you, however, where others in your business have experience with TNT that you begin to use this now. The use of TRACES Classic is scheduled to be removed on 31 December 2021.
