Subject: UPDATE ON IBR TESTING FOR CATTLE EXPORTS TO THE EU & UPDATED TRACES NT APPLICATION FORM FOR EXPORTS

UPDATE ON IBR TESTING FOR CATTLE EXPORTS TO THE EU

Isolation pre-export and blood testing for Infectious Bovine Rhinotracheitis and Infectious Pustular Vulvovaginitis (IBR/IPV) is only required when the destination country is either disease free or has an approved eradication policy.

You can check if a member state has disease freedom or an approved eradication policy by reviewing **Annex V Parts I and II** of Regulation (EU) 2021/620, at the following link

Please note that the ROI is NOT disease-free and does NOT currently have an approved eradication policy, Pre-export isolation/testing is therefore NOT required in this instance. This may differ from advice that you had received previously. We apologise for any confusion this may have caused.

UPDATED TRACES NT APPLICATION FORM FOR EXPORTS

Please be aware that, following feedback from practices, the TRACES NT application form has been modified to include a box for each of:

- 1) Registration number of vehicle at 1.6.
- 2) Weight of consignment at 1.15
- 3) Space for consignment at 1.16
