



- PERMISSION FROM LAND OWNERS
- SCHEDULE 6 APPROVAL FROM DEPARTMENT OF INFRASTRUCTURE RIVERS
 - SECTION 48 APPROVAL FROM DAERA
 - ANY OTHER PERMISSIONS IF THE AREA IS DESIGNATED

MONITORING AFTER WORKS

DOES IT DO WHAT YOU WANTED IT TO DO???

Gravel ford – did it stay - did fish use it to spawn on?

Nursery habitat – do juvenile fish use it – electrofishing surveys – are fish densities greater?

Barrier removal – do fish now get over it?
