Guidance Notes for AIPM 3

Note: this form should only be used to record information for a single premises/ site. Information about additional premises should be provided on separate AIPM 5 forms and returned along with this form.

1. General Information

- a) **Person in day-to-day charge:** Person responsible (on permanent or temporary basis) for daily control of birds and aware of any production problems. Letters about the birds or bird disease will be addressed to this person. If there is a NIPHAS or an EC Egg Layer Establishment Registration Code (Egg Marketing Code) associated with the birds at this address, write it in the space provided.
- b) **Place where the birds are kept:** If you do not keep birds at the address given at part (a) then enter the postal address of the production site, bird house or piece of land where the birds are kept. If there is a NIHPAS or an EC Egg Layer Establishment Registration Code (Egg Marketing Code) associated with the birds at this address, write it in the space provided.
2. **Information Concerning Birds:** Indicate all types of birds kept. Give the maximum number of each type of birds to be kept at any one time.
