POINT of ENTRY INSPECTIONS

at **BELFAST PORT**

Your **load** has been identified as requiring an **inspection**.

What to Expect:

- We will ask for your name and your contact details.
- You will be asked for information about the load, its destination, and the importer.
- Paperwork associated with the load will be inspected.
- A physical inspection may be needed, and you will be asked to help us by providing access and moving animals / goods as needed.

Our officials are authorised under EU and domestic legislation and have legal powers to access and search the load.

When you arrive at the facility, you should:

- · Familiarise yourself with our site rules.
- Switch off your engine and apply vehicle and trailer brakes while waiting.
- Remain inside your vehicle unless specifically asked to assist officials.
- If you must leave your vehicle, wear appropriate protective clothing & footwear.
- If asked, open your vehicle and assist in the movement / lifting of the goods to carry out the inspection.
