



POINT of ENTRY INSPECTIONS

at WARRENPOINT PORT

**Your load has been identified
as requiring an inspection.**



What to Expect:

- We will ask for your name and your contact details.
- You will be asked for information about the load, its destination, and the importer.
- Paperwork associated with the load will be inspected.
- A physical inspection may be needed, and you will be asked to help us by providing access and moving goods as needed.

Our officials are authorised under EU and domestic legislation and have legal powers to access and search the load.

When you arrive at the facility, you should:

- Familiarise yourself with our site rules.
- Switch off your engine and apply vehicle and trailer brakes while waiting.
- Remain inside your vehicle unless specifically asked to assist officials.
- If you must leave your vehicle, wear appropriate protective clothing & footwear.
- If asked, open your vehicle and assist in the movement / lifting of the goods to carry out the inspection.
