The majority of cage egg layers in the UK are based on brown hybrid strains. For the purpose of valuation any differences between strains will be insignificant. Occasionally, a flock of white-feathered layers might be encountered. In this situation, the above valuations should still be used.

This table should be used for laying flocks which are kept for one laying cycle - generally 16 - 86 weeks of age. For moulted flocks please use the separate moulted flocks valuation table.
