Audience: EXPORTERS WHO APPLY FOR EXPORT HEALTH CERTIFICATES (EHCs) VIA DECOL ONLINE SERVICE

Subject: Authorised Veterinary Practice Nomination

Purpose

To advise exporters who apply for Export Health Certificates (EHCs) through DECOL that, where they are applying for certification by an Authorised Veterinary Practice (AVP) the way they nominate that AVP is changing from Monday 10th June 2024.

Background

• At present, exporters must contact their chosen AVP to ensure they are authorised by DAERA to certify any proposed export. This requirement will remain in place.

- Not all AVPs are authorised to certify all commodities. In addition, some third countries require that certain official certificates for animal products are certified and issued by an Official Veterinarian <u>employed</u> <u>by DAERA</u>.
- Therefore, exporters should always check with the chosen practice / vet if certification can be provided for your specific commodity / EHC.

- Once the AVP has confirmed certification of your export is possible, EHC applications should be made via DECOL.
- The DECOL system user guide explains how to make your application, including how to inform DAERA if your export will be certified by an AVP.
