PIG MOVEMENT BOOK - NOTES FOR GUIDANCE

- This movement book meets the requirements of the Pigs (Records, Identification and Movement) Order (Northern Ireland) 2012, Council Regulation (EC) No. 1/2005 on the welfare of animals during transport, and Council Regulation (EC) No. 853/2004 on Food Chain Information (FCI) for pigs sent for human consumption.
- You must only use the movement book that has been allocated to you.
- A separate movement document must be completed for each stage of a multiple move, for example, movements to and from a show.
- You must complete a movement document every time you move pigs between separate holdings. It is not required when moving pigs to other premises within your holding.
- You can use a continuation sheet to list any additional identification numbers, which you can obtain from the DAERA website at www.daera-ni.gov.uk/pigs-irm or your local DAERA Direct Office.
- Movement documents will be rendered invalid if they are modified or defaced in any way.
- Movements of pigs under restriction is an offence and may result in a prosecution unless the movement is authorised by DAERA. Contact your local DAERA Direct Office for authorisation.
- You must **not** receive any pigs onto your holding unless they are accompanied by a movement document.
- If you lose your movement book, notify your local DAERA Direct Office immediately.

How to Complete the Movement Document

- Each movement document consists of an original and 3 self-carbonating copies, which are coloured as shown below. Insert the card at the back of the book between each set of documents.
- You (the keeper at the departure holding) must -
 1. Complete Section 1. If you transport the pigs also complete Section 2.
 2. Provide Food Chain Information (FCI), if necessary, on the back of the **yellow** document. You can provide extra FCI on a separate piece of paper but you must include the movement document serial number on it.
 3. Send the **white** copy to DAERA within 7 days of the movement, unless the movement is to a market, meat plant or show as they will do this for you. Movement documents can be hand delivered or posted to your local DAERA Office.
 4. You can discard the **pink** copy if you, or the buyer, transport the pigs.
 5. Retain the **blue** copy for 3 years from the date of movement, in date order, and cross-reference it in your holding register.
- The transporter must complete Section 2 and retain the pink copy. Guidance on transport rules can be found at the back of the pink copy.
- The yellow (original) must accompany the pigs during transit and be given to the keeper at the destination holding, who must complete Section 3, retain the document for 3 years and cross-reference it in their holding register.

Yellow (original)

This copy must be retained by the keeper at the **destination holding (buyer)**.

It must be kept for at least **3 years** from the date of movement and be cross-referenced in the holding register.

White (first copy)

The keeper at the **departure holding (seller)** must send this copy to DAERA within **7 days** of the movement.

This is not required if the move is to a Market, Meat Plant or Show.

Pink (second copy)

This copy must be retained by the **transporter** for **6 months** if they are not the buyer or seller.

This copy can be discarded if the buyer or seller transports the animals.

Blue (third copy)

This copy must be retained by the keeper at the **departure holding (seller)**.

It must be kept for at least **3 years** from the date of movement and be cross-referenced in the holding register.

Food Chain Information (FCI) Statements

The keeper at the holding of departure (seller) must complete the table below if the following Food Chain Information (FCI) Statements are not satisfied for all pigs listed on the movement document:

1. Withdrawal periods have been observed for all veterinary medicinal products and other treatments administered to the animals while on this holding and previous holdings.
2. To the best of my knowledge the animals are not showing signs of any disease or condition that may affect the safety of meat derived from them.
3. The herd is not under restriction for animal health or other reasons.
4. No analysis of samples taken from animals on the holding or other samples has shown that the animals in this consignment may have been exposed to any disease or condition that may affect the safety of meat, or to substances likely to result in residues in meat.

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Statements for the Export of Pig Meat to the People's Republic of China

- The pigs were born and reared in the United Kingdom.
- A veterinary declaration of freedom from the diseases specified below as required for the herd(s) of origin for the export of pig meat to China has been provided in the previous three (3) months.
- The holding(s) from which the pigs were derived are not situated in an area subject to official restrictions due to a notifiable disease to which pigs are susceptible according to European Animal Health Regulations.
- To the best of my knowledge and belief, there has been no clinical occurrence of the following diseases on the premises within the previous six (6) months: (i) Anthrax (*Bacillus anthracis* infection), Aujeszky's disease, porcine brucellosis or tuberculosis (*Mycobacterium bovis* infection); (ii) Progressive atrophic rhinitis (toxigenic *Pasteurella multocida* infection) or trichinellosis (*Trichinella species* infection); (iii) Porcine reproductive and respiratory syndrome.

Notes for Guidance - Completion of a Movement Document (Destination Holding)

The keeper at the destination holding must complete Section 3 of the yellow (original) document; keep it for 3 years from the date of movement; in date order; and cross-reference it in the holding register. The 3 yes/no questions should only be completed for moves to an assured farm or meat plant. DOA means dead on arrival.

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Notes for Guidance - Completion of a Movement Document (Transporter)

- The person transporting the animals must complete Section 2 of the movement document.
- The yellow (original) movement document must accompany the pigs during transit.
- The transporter must give the yellow (original) movement document to the keeper at the destination holding (buyer).
- If the transporter is the departure or destination keeper the pink copy of the movement document can be discarded. Otherwise the transporter must retain the pink copy for 6 months.
- Transporters must be authorised to transport animals in connection with an economic activity on a journey of more than 65km (around 40 miles).
- If this journey is more than 65km you must complete the boxes in the grey shaded area, including your Transporters Authorisation Number.
- Prior to any long journey (over 8 hours long) DAERA must also approve a journey log and this must accompany the animals during transport in compliance with Annex II of Council Regulation (EC) No. 1/2005. For long journeys enter the chassis number of the trailer transporting the pigs in the “Vehicle Reg./Trailer ID. box”.
- The duration of any journey is the time from when the first animal is loaded at the place of departure, until the time when the last animal is unloaded at the place of destination, including any stops for rests or any other purpose en route.
